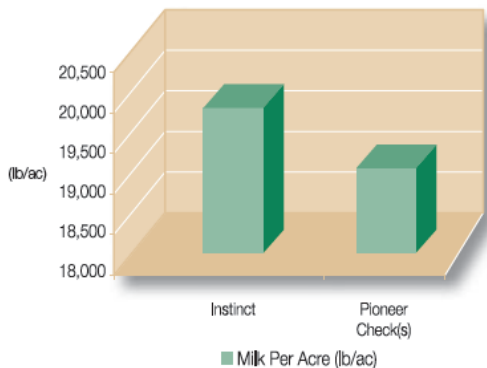

Considering Instinct provides this required level of disease resistance in combination with high yield potential and improved forage quality choosing this variety is a great way to maximize your productivity.

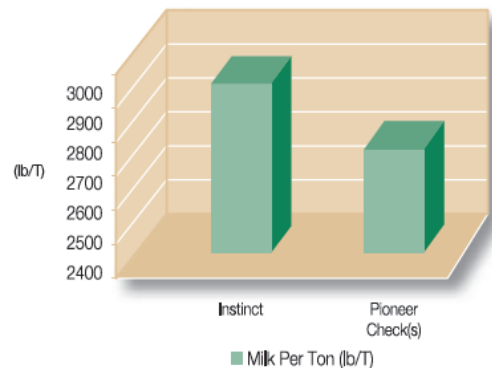
