

Pickseed Exels in Provincial Corn Trials

The Ontario Corn Committee conducts replicated corn performance trials each year across the province of Ontario. PICKSEED enters corn hybrids into these trials to test the overall performance against popular competitor products.

The 2015 report has presented exciting results for PICKSEED corn hybrids:

PS 2750RR is ranked #1 in the Table 1 trial over the past 2 seasons with a yield of 181 bushels/acre and a yield index of 109%.

PS 2552RR is a new product for 2016 and is ranked #2 in the Table 1 trial over the past 2 seasons with a yield of 178 bushels/acre and a yield index of 107%.

PS 2844VT2P RIB is ranked #1 in the Table 2 trial over the past 2 seasons with a yield of 210 bushels/acre and a yield index of 110%.

PS 2818GSX RIB is a new product for 2016 and is ranked #2 in the Table 3 trial in the 2015 growing season with a yield of 226 bushels/acre and a yield index of 109%.

PS 3155GSX RIB will be a new product for 2017 and is ranked #3 in the Table 4 trial in the 2015 growing season with a yield of 236 bushels/acre and a yield index of 106%.

Overall, PICKSEED products are exhibiting impressive performance results in the Ontario Corn Committee trials and we are looking forward to another great growing season ahead for 2016.
